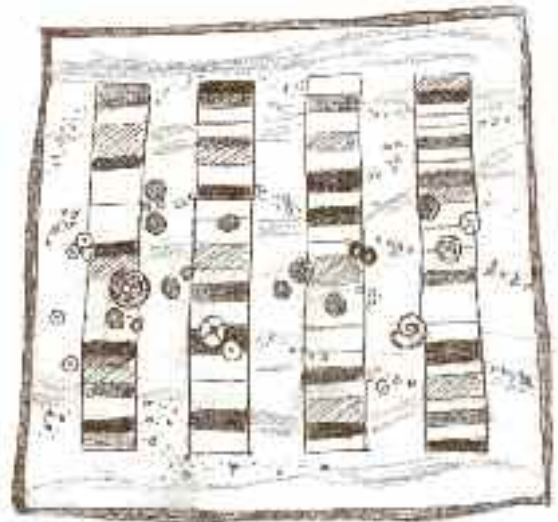

## Did You Know?

### QUILT HISTORY IN THE MAKING...

One of the oldest surviving examples of European quilts dates from about 1395 A.D. and is in The Victoria & Albert Museum in London. It is one of three trapunto quilts made in a Sicilian workshop. The quilt depicts 14 scenes from the battle of Tristan, and was probably crafted by a group of artisans.
