ROAD TRIP! JULY 23–27

The tenth annual South Central Wisconsin Quilters Road Trip will be held **Wednesday, July 23 through Sunday, July 27**. At each store you will receive a free fat quarter and a free Wyoming star block pattern. Each store has designed a project using the Wyoming Star and will have kits available. **Twenty-six fabulous prizes** will be given out. We will draw from returned passports. Our two grand prizes are a \$200 gift certificate for the long arm quilter of your choice and a \$200 gift certificate at a quilting retreat of your choice. You must visit all twelve stores to be eligible for the grand prizes. Twelve first prizes will be drawn from passports stamped with at least nine stores. Twelve second prizes will be drawn from passports stamped with at least six stores.

Pick up your free passport at the first store you visit. **Core shop hop hours are 9:30-6:00 Wednesday through Saturday and 12:00-4:00 on Sunday**. If a store is normally open longer hours, they will be open their regular hours. Buses visiting six stores each day will run on Thursday and Friday. Bus reservation forms are available at each participating store and must be postmarked by June 25.

BUCK A BLOCK



We've been very pleased with your response to the Buck A Block program. Each year the program has a new design. We have decided to begin our year in September instead of January, so for this fall there will be an overlap of Series 4 & 5. The Buck a Block program entitles you to a kit for \$1 a month for 12 months as long as you follow the rules. The rules state that when you sign up, you get the current month's kit for \$1. As long as you make the block and bring it to the store any time during the next month, you will continue to get the current month's kit for \$1. Any past month's kit is \$3. If you do more than one colorway, you get the first kit for a dollar and each additional kit for \$3. **Buck a Block 4 started in January.** You may still sign up to start this program. We have three different store samples showing the fabric combinations you may choose. A limited number of finishing kits are available if you choose to complete the quilt as we have done. **Buck a Block 5 will be starting in September.** It's another great pattern using slightly smaller Thangles and setting the blocks on point. Both a twin and queen size option are given. We're working on our samples and will have at least two different fabric choices for you.

Your choice of trim can be as bright or subtle as you like. The samples use narrow strips of the shirt knit cut from the bottom for shortening.

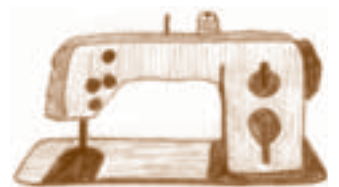

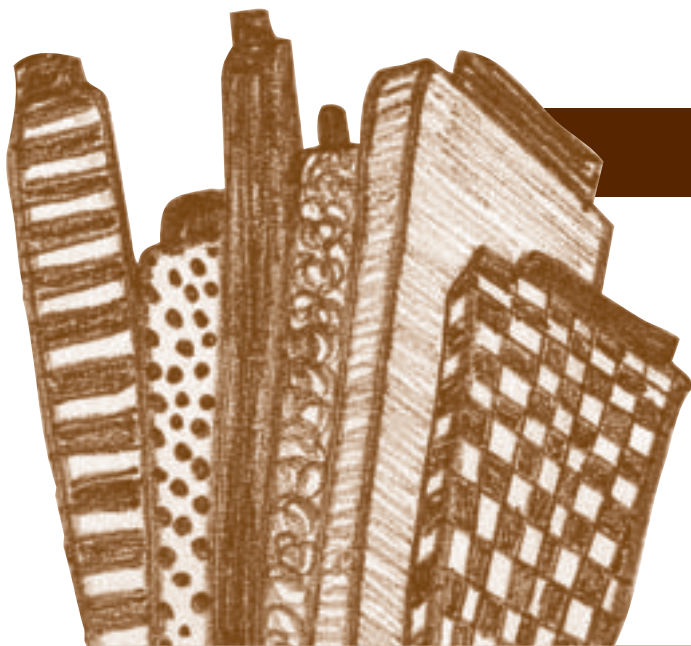
